Hiking: planned 3-5 hour hike with local guide: \$23/person (must be 12 or older, minors must be accompanied by a parent) Self-guided hikes are available at no charge; please do not hike alone.

Transportation from Atlanta Airport: Shared costs to and from the airport in Atlanta on arrival and departure day are estimated at \$60 each way. You must arrive in Atlanta airport no later than noon on Sunday, and expect to get to the airport in Atlanta no earlier than 4 p.m. on Saturday.
